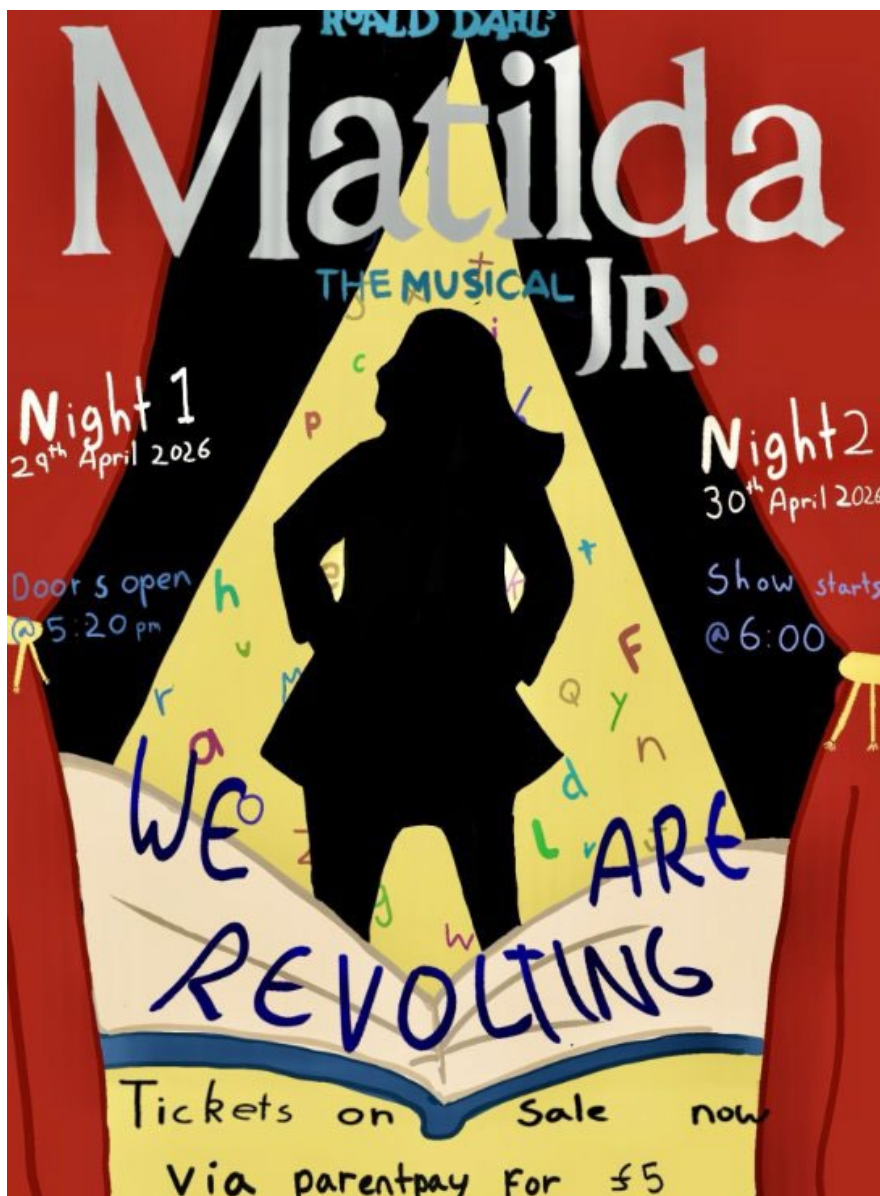
so much effort, thank you all for your continued hard work and enthusiasm.

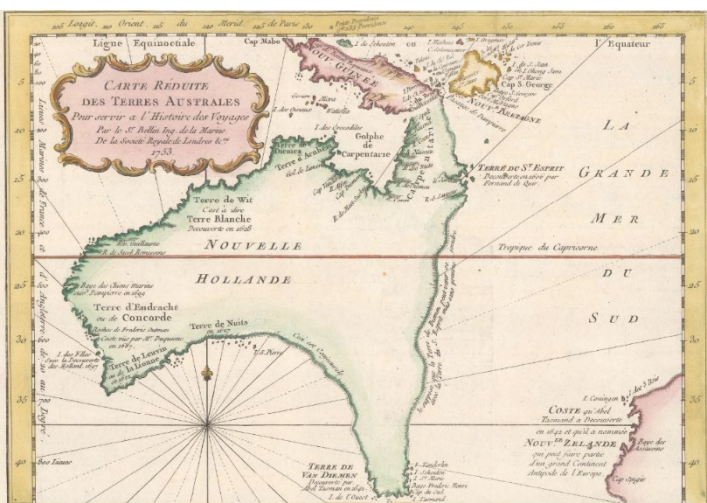

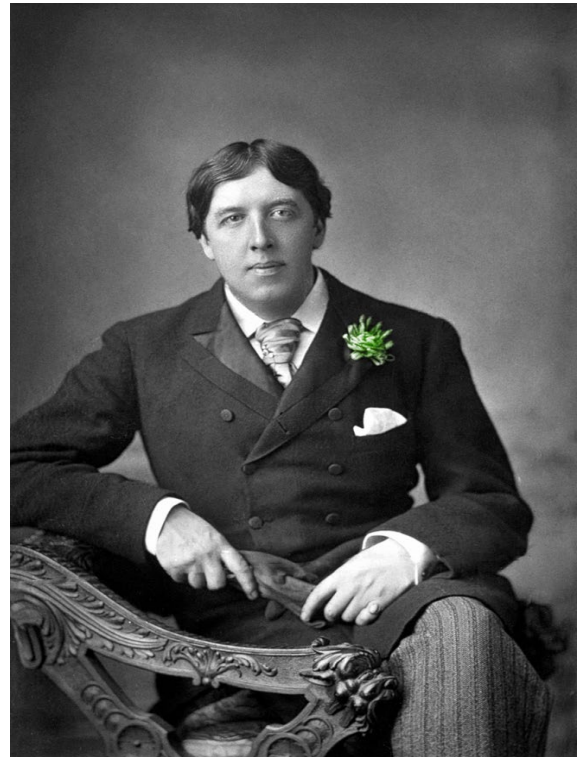
Wilde's Rebellion

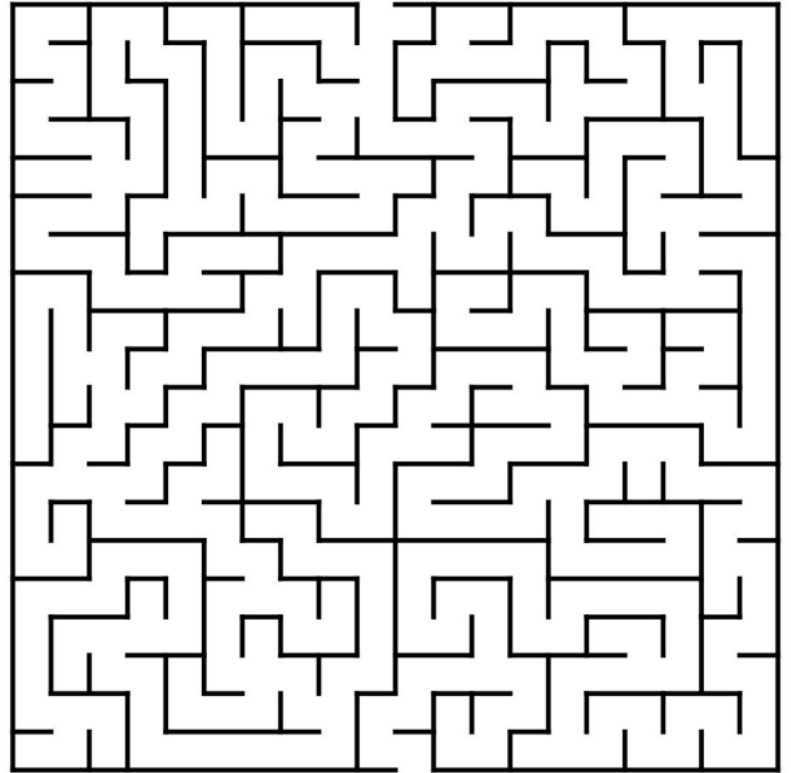
