Morse code, made by Samuel Morse, is a form of telecommunication (communication through wires).

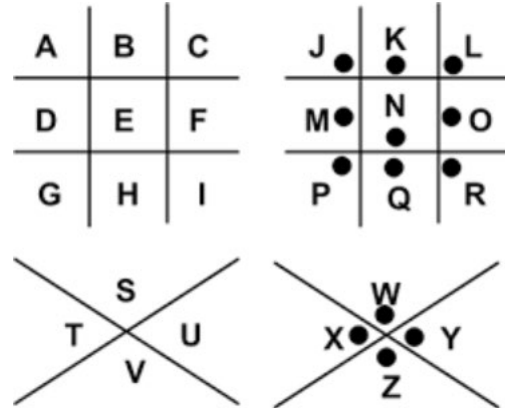
It uses short electrical bursts to create short or long beeps (dots and dashes). It was most used during the first and second world war.

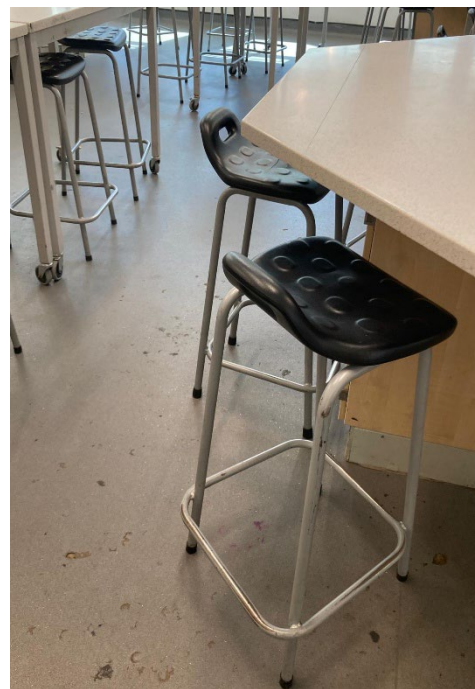
6th

Our first honourable mention is teacher chairs because of their super comfortable backs I really think there's no debate about this.

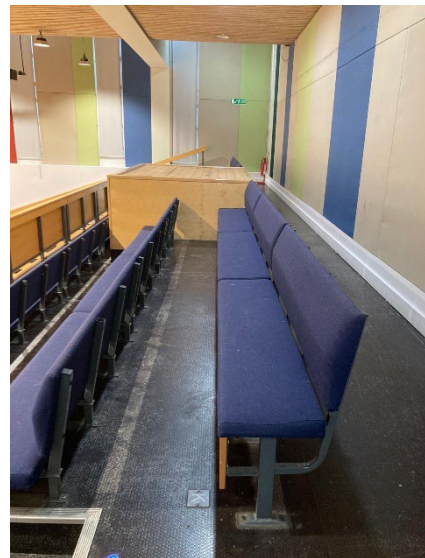


Moving on we have the sofa in red village because of its comfortable and cute cushions and it's just a sofa.
