Dear Parents & Carers

Parent Pay

Thank you to all the parents who have signed up for an account. We need all parents to sign up, even if your child doesn't have school meals. This is because not only is this a payment system for things such as meals, snacks and trips, it will also become the main way in which we communicate to parents, so you must have an account to receive communications from school.

From September, students will not be allowed to pay cash, and the top up machines will be removed.

Covid 19 Arrangements for September

As I'm sure you have seen, the key restrictions on education will come to an end at step 4 of the Government's roadmap on the 19th July. Year groups are no longer to be in bubbles, and from August 16th, under 18s will no longer be required to isolate if they are a close contact, unless they test positive for Covid 19 themselves.

We expect that there will still need to be some measures in school, including regular washing and sanitising of hands throughout the day, and enhanced cleaning.

We will be asking parents and carers not to send their child to school if they have any kind of illness or symptoms, and stay at home and seek a PCR Covid test.

Covid 19 Testing for Students

As you will have seen above, the government are asking that students complete two Lateral Flow Covid tests on site. Testing is voluntary, although pupils are strongly encouraged to participate as testing will help to identify positive cases more quickly and break the chains of transmission.

If you have already given consent earlier this year when we last did testing – you DO NOT need to complete this again, however if you have not yet given consent for your child to be tested, please can you complete this online consent form by clicking this link (please see electronic version of letter on our website).

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Uniform and Equipment

All uniform needs to be ordered online – please see the information enclosed for guidance. The website address is https://www.pbuniform-online.co.uk/cityacademy

The school uniform we require is as follows:

- Blazer with Academy Logo must be ordered online
- Tie must be ordered online. For next year the colours will be as follows:

Year 7 - Green

Year 8 - Purple

Year 9 - Yellow

Year 10 - Red

Year 11 - Blue

Please note that this is for replacement ties – if your child already has a different colour, this is fine.

- You are welcome to purchase a sweater with Academy Logo, but this is optional but this must be ordered online
- White shirt/blouse can be purchased anywhere
- Black Trousers or skirt can be purchased anywhere
- Black shoes (Not trainers) can be purchased anywhere

The school PE Kit we require is as follows:

- Red long socks must be ordered online
- Red PE T shirt or polo shirt

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- Red PE jumper or long-sleeved games top must be ordered online
- Black shorts or black skort can be purchased anywhere
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms or plain black sports leggings can be purchased anywhere
- Trainers and football boots with studs or moulded studs can be purchase anywhere but must be suitable for 4G pitches.

Students must also have:

- A bag large enough to fit an A4 sized textbook
- A pencil case containing pens, pencils, a rubber, a sharpener and a ruler
- A calculator

Students will be issued with an A5 sized planner on their first day in September, which must be carried at all times.
