You will know from the reverse communication yesterday that Mr Angell has decided to resign as Principal of City Academy Bristol from September 2021. He will go on to take up a role as Head and Director of Eastern Community Campus.

We have greatly valued Jon's collegiality since he joined the school in 2015. During his tenure Jon led the school on a journey of rapid improvement, achieving a 'Good' judgement from Ofsted, gaining the trust of the community to the extent that the school is now oversubscribed. He worked to support families of key worker children from a range of local schools during the pandemic period as a community leader, and has played a significant role in the leadership of education across Bristol, as chair of the Headteachers' Forum.

We are sure that you will join us in thanking Mr Angell for his hard work and commitment during his time at City Academy Bristol. We wish him well for the future, and he has written to you personally below.

From September, the school will be led by Mr Ben Tucker, currently Vice Principal, who will take on the role of Interim Principal at the start of the school year. He will be supported by the Cabot Learning Federation, working closely with Sally Apps, Executive Principal, who has worked with City Academy staff closely this year and has a strong knowledge of the East and Central Bristol educational landscape, having previously led both Bristol Metropolitan Academy and John Cabot Academy. Later in the year, there will be a formal process to appoint a permanent Principal, the details of which will be shared with you and your children in due course. The 2021/22 academic year holds a great deal of potential for all in the City Academy community, under Mr Tucker's leadership and with Mrs Apps' support. Whilst Mr Tucker is a very familiar and highly respected member of the City Academy community, there will be opportunities to find out more about his plans for the Academy, and to meet Mrs Apps, at parent forum events in September.
