Earlier today, colleagues and I met with the local NEU reps and further progress was made towards resolving the outstanding points of dispute.

The NEU reps informed us at the close of today's discussions that they now intend to take the latest proposals to their members on Monday, 29 April at 3.30pm. Pending the outcome of their discussions however, NEU members are currently planning to take two further days of strike action next week, on Tuesday, April 30th and Wednesday, May 1st.

I will of course write to update you further at the end of Monday; however regardless of the outcome of that meeting, the school will remain open to all students throughout next week. Do please ensure your child continues to attend as normal, as good attendance remains a vital component of a successful education.
