#### **Covid-19 Testing**

With up to 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 not displaying any symptoms, rapid LFT testing remains a vital tool to help us stay ahead of the virus. The twice-weekly regular testing habit is as important as ever and we would urge you to continue to encourage your children to test. Testing kits are given out regularly to students, but if you need any more please ask your child to ask at reception.

We've also been asked by the local public health teams to remind families that lateral flow tests are for people with no symptoms only.
