To clarify, full school uniform students require is as follows:

- White shirt/blouse Can be purchased anywhere
- School tie Must be ordered online (<u>click here</u>) or purchased at our reception (£7)
- Black trousers or skirt Can be purchased anywhere
- Black non-branded footwear Can be purchased anywhere
- School bag
- PE kit Purchased online

Students will be required to access our Swap Shop to borrow items on occasions they do not come to school in full uniform. This will be followed up with a phone call home to make you aware. Please support your child in attending school wearing appropriate uniform. We are also here to help – if you do need support or help with purchasing uniform, please contact Vanessa Benjamin (vanessa.benjamin@clf.uk or 0117 954 2853).

Jackets, hoodies, hats, mobile phones, head/EarPods should not be visible or worn when inside the academy building. Academy staff **will** confiscate these items, and students will not get them back until the end of the school day.

Attendance and punctuality to school and lessons

Our breakfast club begins at 7.45 each morning. Our main school gates open at 8:30am to support students attending tutor time for 8:40am. All students should attend school each day and on time. If your child is unwell, please contact our school reception before the start of the school day.

Students should also attend and be punctual and attend each lesson to ensure they maximise their learning experience. Students who truant one lesson will receive a 1-hour detention, and at risk of suspension if they truant on more than one occasion during a day.
