Following the Government announcement on Monday, we are really looking forward to having students back in school. We want to thank you and your children for your hard work and support over this last period of lockdown.

We are planning that all students return to City Academy from Wednesday 10th March.

Student Testing

The Government have asked that secondary students carry out 3 lateral flow tests in school over the coming weeks. Testing is voluntary, although pupils are strongly encouraged to participate as testing regularly will help to identify positive cases more quickly and break the chains of transmission.

Test 1 - will take place in school, for all students whose parents have given consent as follows:

Thursday 4th March – students to arrive via the side entrance into the Theatre

- Year 7 Between 9.30am and 11am
- Year 8 Between 11.30am and 1pm

Friday 5th March – students to arrive via the side entrance into the Theatre

- Year 9 Between 9.30am and 10.30am
- Year 10 Between 11.00am and 12pm
- Year 11 Between 12pm and 1pm

Test 2 - will take place in school, for all students whose parents have given consent as follows:

Monday 8th March – students to arrive via the side entrance into the Theatre

- Year 7 Between 9.30am and 11am
- Year 8 Between 11.30am and 1pm

Tuesday 9th March

- Year 9 Between 9.30am and 10.30am
- Year 10 Between 11.00am and 12pm
- Year 11 Between 12pm and 1pm

Test 3 - the third test will take place during the school day on Thursday 11th March and Friday 12th March.

You may have seen via the media, that there will be home testing kits available for students whose parents give consent for them to be testing. This will begin after Monday 15th March. We will update you as soon as possible with further information on the supply of test kits etc.

Re-Opening for Students

Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 - From Monday 1st March until Wednesday 3rd March, students should continue to attend live online lessons. From Thursday 4th March until Tuesday 9th March, Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be set online work via Microsoft Teams, following their normal timetable, these will not be live lessons, but assignments set.

Year 11 – Continue to follow their online assessment 1 program until Friday 5th March, and then on Monday 8th March and Tuesday 9th March they will be set online work via Microsoft Teams, following their normal timetable, these will not be live lessons, but assignments set.

On Wednesday 10th March, all students will be returning to school, at the following times. They will be having an induction day. <u>This will be a staggered start; the timings will be confirmed to you next week.</u>

From Thursday 11th March students will be returning to their normal lessons, in their normal classrooms. Each day they will need to arrive by 8.30am to the following gates:

- Year 7 & 8 Yellow
- Year 9, 10 & 11 White

Students will leave via these gates, each day of the week:

- Year 7 & 8 Yellow
- Year 9, 10 & 11 Red

INSET day postponed

According to our calendar for this year, we were due to hold an Inset day on March 17th. In light recent developments, and our intention to commit fully to supporting the return of all learners, we have postponed the trust wide INSET day that was planned for 17th March until Friday 28th May (the final day of term 5). This is so that we can dedicate our time in the short term to supporting our children to reengage with learning and with their peers.

Face Masks

The Government now recommends that the use of face coverings in secondary schools is extended for a limited period to all indoor environments - including classrooms - unless 2m social distancing can be maintained.
