Heatwave Information

We are currently in a Level 3: Amber warning for high temperatures in the coming days, likely to last until Wednesday July 20th.

We will ensure temperatures in school are kept as low as possible by keeping blinds closed and opening windows and doors, and use fans where available.

Students will be able to stay inside at break and lunch if they choose to do so, and there is shaded areas outside. We encourage students to apply sun cream before coming to school and are welcome to bring their own to reapply during the day.

Hydration

Please ensure your child comes to school with a bottle of water which can be refilled in academy during the day. Pupils will be encouraged to drink fluids regularly throughout the day and specifically after break and lunch.

Uniform


On Monday and Tuesday, we will be allowing students to continue to wear shorts, or wear their City Academy PE Kit to help students stay cool. Students do not need to wear a tie.

All of the above measures will assist in keeping a reasonable temperature inside, and of course as always we will continue to dynamically assess throughout the day.
