**Dear Parents and Carers** 

During the half - term holiday we have been informed that a Year 7 student has tested positive for Covid 19. The student was last in school on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October. We are taking the highest precautions and following the national guidance and the advice from our local Health Protection Team.

All close contacts of the Year 7 student have now been identified and instructed to self-isolate. Your child is not a contact of the affected Year 7 student so does not need to self isolate. Therefore your child has been able to return to the Academy today on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November as normal.

Please be assured we are continuing with our strict hygiene measures with enhanced cleaning throughout the building, including disinfectant fogging the entire building every day.

## What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, you should inform the school and organise for your child to be tested via the NHS online portal or by calling 119. Your household should isolate until you receive the test results giving the all clear.

## Symptoms of COVID 19

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or •
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia) •

For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

## How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19. Do:

- wash your hands with soap and water often do this for at least 20 seconds .
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
