Dear Parents and Carers of Year 10 Students

This morning we were informed that one of our Year 10 students has tested positive for Covid 19. The student was last in school on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> November. We are taking the highest precautions and following the national guidance and the advice from our local Health Protection Team.

This morning we identified which students may have been in close contact with the student who tested positive.

We have identified that your child may have been contact with the affected student in school. **Therefore, your child needs to self-isolate** and stay at home and not come into contact with anyone outside of your household, until the end of the day on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> November. Your Year 10 student can return to school on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November.

There is no need for other family members to isolate unless someone in your household develop symptoms. You do not need to get your child tested for Covid-19 unless they, or anyone in your household, develops symptoms.

Please be assured we are continuing with our strict hygiene measures with enhanced cleaning throughout the building, including disinfectant fogging the entire building every day.

The main symptoms of coronavirus, given on the NHS website <a href="https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/">https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/</a> are shown below and most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
