## Dear Parents and Carers of Year 7 Students

During the last 2 weeks in line with the raising infection rate for Covid-19 that is happening nationally and locally we have had several positive staff cases, as well as a positive case in year 7. We also have a number of staff who are having to remain at home for isolation or childcare reasons due to their own children's school sending students home.

In the letter sent to you yesterday, I mentioned that these staff shortages led to the partial closure of the school, and as a consequence Year 9 students have been learning at home since Tuesday and they are returning to site on Monday.

Due to the challenges around staffing, and keeing students safe, I have unfortunately had to take the decision that Year 7 students do not attend the Academy on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> November. This is due to more than half of year 7 lessons would have needed to be covered by supply teachers.

This is a difficult decision to make, but I must ensure that at all times students can be safely cared for onsite and next week this would not be possible with the numbers of staff available. All other year group students will be able to attend as usual.

The nature of Covid-19 is that the picture is dynamic and can change very rapidly, so I will review the staffing levels on Tuesday and communicate a decision about the rest of the week to you by Tuesday afternoon.

Please note that although Year 7 students are being asked to learn at home, this is not self-isolation and they are able to leave the house in line with the current lockdown restrictions, for example for exercise or in order to shop for essential supplies, <u>unless you have been informed that your year 7 student should isolate</u>.

Staff will deliver Year 7 student lessons through Microsoft Teams. Please see the information below. Full timetable attendance is expected from every student unless unwell.

Should your child not have access to laptop or the internet please do contact the school and we will do our utmost to deliver a laptop or a set of resources – alternatively we could have these ready for collection.

Students who are entitled to free school meals will be sent a supermarket voucher as soon as possible to cover the values of the meals for the 2 days.

## **Home Learning Information**







