Dear Parents and Carers of Year 7 Students

Due to the challenges around staffing, and keeping students safe, I have unfortunately had to take the decision that Year 7 students do not attend the Academy next week.

I appreciate that this news is disappointing, particularly since your child has already had one week of distance learning and is likely to be looking forward to returning to school with friends. I wanted you to be aware that the decision has been carefully considered today and that to continue at distance is considered the safest and best option.

As you know, I had hoped for Year 7 to return tomorrow, and until earlier today this was the plan; however, in the last few hours a number of staff have become unwell or unavailable due to matters relating to Covid-19, leading to significant pressures on staffing on site. To bring your child back to an environment where I cannot guarantee safety and a strong learning experience is unconscionable.

I hope that to have a little notice this afternoon rather than being presented with this situation on Monday morning gives you at least a small window within which to plan for next week as a family. I will look forward to seeing your child in person on Monday 30th November, and will do all I can to ensure that this happens.

Please note that although Year 7 students are being asked to learn at home, this is not self-isolation and they are able to leave the house in line with the current lockdown restrictions, for example for exercise or in order to shop for essential supplies, <u>unless you have been informed that</u> your year 7 student should isolate.

Staff will deliver Year 7 student lessons through Microsoft Teams. Please see the information below. Attendence is expected from every student unless unwell. There may be some lessons not able to run via Teams. Students should check their calendar invitations on teams at their normal lesson times. If there is not an invite, then the work for that lesson will be available on student navigator.

Thank you in advance for your support and understanding and please do accept my apologies for the inconvenience that this will undoubtedly cause for you and your families. The decision has not been taken lightly and student safety is always my priority.

Home Learning Information

Students will follow their usual school timetable to allow them to continue to study a well sequenced curriculum, however the lesson time will be reduced from 55 minutes a session to 40 minutes a session to allow students a break from the screens. 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





