Dear Parents and Carers of Year 9 Students,

During last week and over the weekend, in line with the raising infection rate for Covid-19 that is happening nationally and locally, we have had several positive staff cases. We also have a number of staff who are having to remain at home for isolation. Either due to being identified through Track and Trace or for childcare reasons due to their own children's school sending students home. As a result, we have over 15 members of staff already absent for this week.

Therefore, unfortunately, I have had to take the decision that Year 9 students do not attend the Academy all of next week. I have chosen this year group as more than half of year 9 lessons would have needed to be covered by supply teachers.

This is a difficult decision to make, but I must ensure that at all times students can be safely cared for onsite and next week this would not be possible with the numbers of staff available. All other year group students will be able to attend as usual.

Based on current staffing levels and the ability of staff to return from isolation, I expect the remote learning for Year 9 to be for next week only. At this stage I expect to be able to welcome Year 9 students back on site from Monday 12th July. I will review the staffing levels on Thursday and communicate a decision about the following week at that stage to help you with your planning. Should the situation improve I will immediately recall year 9 into school.

Please note that although Year 9 students are being asked to learn at home, this is not self-isolation unless you have previously been contacted by the Academy last week. Staff will deliver Year 9 student live lessons through Microsoft Teams. Please see the information below. Full timetable attendance is expected from every student unless unwell.

Should your child not have access to laptop or the internet please do contact the school and we will do our utmost to deliver a laptop or a set of resources – alternatively we could have these ready for collection.

Thank you in advance for your support and understanding and please do accept my apologies for the inconvenience that this will undoubtedly cause for you and your families. The decision has not been taken lightly and student safety is always my priority.



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Home Learning Information

Students will follow their usual school timetable to allow them to continue to study a well sequenced curriculum, however the lesson time will be reduced from 55 minutes a session to 40 minutes a session to allow students a break from the screens. 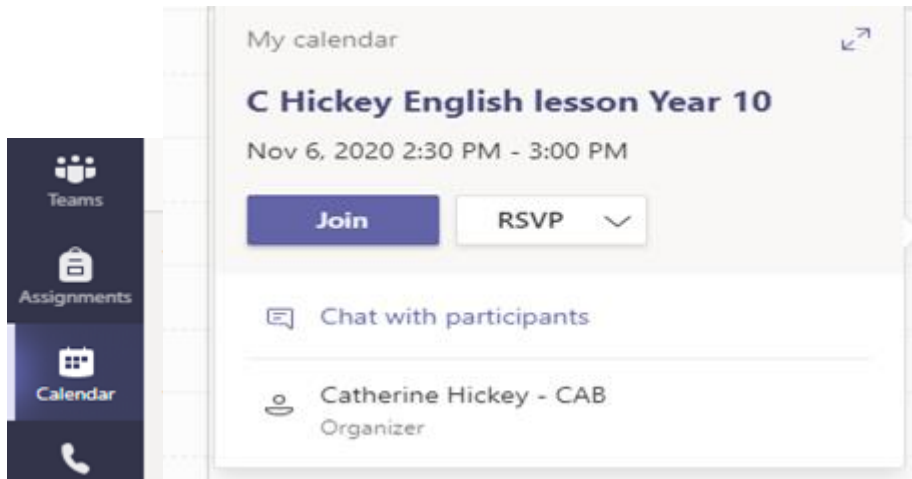
