Dear Parents and Carers of Year 9 Students

As you are aware, this morning we received a confirmed case of Covid-19 from one of our Year 9 students. The student was last in school on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> October. We are taking the highest precautions and following the national guidance and the advice from our local Health Protection Team.

Earlier today we sent all of year 9 home for the rest of today, and tomorrow, whilst we identified students who have been in close contact with the student who tested positive.

We have identified that your child may have been contact with the affected student in school. Therefore, your child needs to self-isolate and stay at home and not come into contact with anyone outside of your household, until Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> October. Your Year 9 student can return to school after half term as normal on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

There is no need for other family members to isolate unless someone in your household develop symptoms. You do not need to get your child tested for Covid-19 unless they, or anyone in your household, develops symptoms.

Please be assured we are continuing with our strict hygiene measures with enhanced cleaning throughout the building, including disinfectant fogging the entire building every day.

The main symptoms of coronavirus, given on the NHS website <a href="https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/">https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/</a> are shown below and most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
