## **Covid 19 Arrangements for September**

Year groups will be kept apart as much as possible from arrival, throughout the school day and on departure from school. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide breakfast whilst these arrangements are in place. Students will be expected to arrive at a specific gate and enter the Academy from 8.30am until 8.40am. They will leave at the end of the day through the gate to which they arrived in the morning.

Students will enter via 5 entrances. These will be determined in advance according to where that Year group bubble will be for lessons that day. There are specific places for break time and lunch time for each group. Students will be given their timetable during their induction day which will show which gate they must go to each day. We will have staff on duty at the front of school and on all gates to help direct students. Please can you do everything you can to encourage your child to go to the correct entrance and not meet at the front of the school, especially at the end of the day. We need to make sure that we are following the government guidelines about social distancing and no large groups. I would also encourage you to get your children to walk or bike to school. This is a really healthy way to travel, it's better for the climate and air pollution and is often quicker.

Students will be asked to wash and sanitise their hands throughout the day. We are continuing our hygiene measures with enhanced cleaning throughout the building.

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Students must bring their own pencil case and a bottle of water labelled with their name. Students can bring a bag with their books in, but we are unable to allow students to use lockers so please only bring in items that can fit comfortably in their bag.

On days where students have PE, they are to wear their PE kit to school and can wear it all day to avoid the use of the changing rooms. On other days we would like students to wear uniform as recommended by the government guidance.

### Permanent changes to the timing of the school day, lessons and Learning Family.

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## **Uniform and Equipment**

## The school uniform we require is as follows:

- Blazer with Academy Logo must be ordered online
- Tie must be ordered online. For next year the colours will be as follows:

Year 7 - Purple

Year 8 - Yellow

Year 9 - Red

Year 10 - Blue

Year 11 - Green

Please note that this is for replacement ties – if your child already has a different colour, this is fine.

- You are welcome to purchase a sweater with Academy Logo, but this is optional but this must be ordered online
- White shirt/blouse can be purchased anywhere
- Black Trousers or skirt can be purchased anywhere
- Black shoes (Not trainers) can be purchased anywhere

### The school PE Kit we require is as follows:

- Red long socks must be ordered online
- Red PE T shirt or polo shirt

  must be ordered online
- Red PE jumper or long-sleeved games top must be ordered online
- Black shorts or black skort can be purchased anywhere
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms or plain black sports leggings can be purchased anywhere
- Trainers and football boots with studs or moulded studs can be purchase anywhere but must be suitable for 4G pitches.

#### Students must also have:

- A bag large enough to fit an A4 sized textbook
- A pencil case containing pens, pencils, a rubber, a sharpener and a ruler
- A calculator

Students will be issued with an A4 sized planner on their first day in September, which must be carried at all times.

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## Guidance on the use of face coverings

The guidance from the Government on this last week is that face coverings are only necessary in secondary schools in an area of local intervention (as listed on this <u>government website</u>), where they should be worn by adults and pupils when moving around the school, such as in corridors and communal areas. However, they should not be worn in classrooms, where protective measures already mean the risks are lower, and where they can inhibit learning.

For us in City Academy, as with all of our CLF colleagues, as we are not in an area of local intervention, there is **no recommendation for face coverings** to be worn by staff or pupils, except where they are using public transport to get to school. Instead, we will be following the existing guidance carefully, and will be training and informing all staff and pupils about how to keep themselves and others safe when coming to and from, and being in school.

#### Travel to and from school

The Government has advised parents, carers, staff and pupils walk or cycle to school if at all possible, and drive rather than using public transport, especially at peak times. Where pupils are using public transport, it is important to be aware of the regulations for children over the age of 11 regarding face coverings, where they are mandatory.

#### Attendance

Unlike in the period before the summer, when pupils' attendance to school was not compulsory, the Government has now made clear that it expects all children to attend school. This means that the duty for schools and parents and carers to ensure that children attend is back in place. We would expect the majority of pupils will be able to return to school except where, in line with public health advice, they are self-isolating and have had symptoms or a positive test result themselves, or because they are a close contact of someone who has coronavirus (COVID-19). Shielding advice for all adults and children was paused on 1 August 2020, which means that any pupils who are on the shielded patient list can also return to school.
