Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing today to give you a general update following a period of turbulence caused by the pandemic, and to ask for your support as we move into December.

Cases continue to rise in our local area. Bristol currently has some of the highest rates in the country and in the Academy, we are reflecting this rise, as you know. We would always hope to avoid positive cases in the academy, however, in the current situation in our area it is inevitable that cases will arise. We have well-practiced protocols in the academy to keep staff and students safe and a robust procedure to track and trace cases that transpire amongst our staff and students. All of this is serving to reduce the spread of the virus and, as always, Public Health England advice is being followed rigorously. One positive piece of news is that the lockdown period is starting to have an impact on infection rates, which, although high, are starting to reduce – this is reassuring.

Public Health England have fed back to us with every case we have reported that there is unlikely to have been onward transmission in school and the systems we have in place are effective. This is also reassuring. A reminder that all students (other than those exempt) must wear a face covering in school corridors and communal areas.

We are learning all the time about how to improve our approach to distance learning and live learning sessions. We have learnt a great deal from the feedback from students and families and have continued to refine our approach in supporting students with their distance learning. We have provided laptops and Wifi Dongles wherever possible to families to support with learning at home and have been able to provide work for every student.

Currently we have three year groups learning at home. As you might expect, they will continue to be provided with a full timetable of distance and live learning from their own teachers wherever possible to keep up with their studies in this important year. Staff have been working tirelessly to prepare for online delivery and to support students with their learning remotely. I will contact you again prior to the weekend to detail whether any year groups will need to remain at home next week as our staffing continues to be under pressure from the virus. I would like Year 7 families to know that their children will be prioritised for time on site next week and should expect to return to school on 30th November, bringing with them a face covering.

We have made sure that students are well fed by providing healthy snacks at breaktime, a hot food or sandwich option at lunchtimes and sending supermarket vouchers for our free school meals students who are isolating at home.
