Year 11 Post 16 Pathways

This is an exciting time for year 11 students where they have control about where they want to study and what course they want to do. It can be overwhelming though, and it can be difficult to know where to start. A great place to start is the Bristol Post 16 Course Directory 2023 <https://www.bristol.gov.uk/files/documents/4992-bristol-post-16-directory-2023/file>, this lists all the educational providers in Bristol and all the courses available. Worth a look!

Throughout term 1 and 2 Colleges and Sixth Forms are being invited into school during assembly to talk to students about what they have to offer. The school will also be offering small group sessions for specific needs. Students need to look out for the workshops that interest them and sign up.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a good alternative for students who do not want to study an academic subject. What draws people to apprenticeships is that you can 'earn while you learn'. A good place to start looking for one is on the below websites. It takes time to find the perfect one.

Top tips –

- ★ Sign up and set up an alert on the government website so they send you new vacancies which come up <https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship>
- ★ If a student is predicted 5 GCSEs at 4 and above you are looking at a level 3 apprenticeship to do next. This can vary for different sectors.
- ★ Be patient
- ★ You might have to apply for 10 vacancies before you are successful

We are inviting Junior in who runs the ASK apprenticeship programme and he will give the students lots of expert help.
