Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer,

Information regarding GCSE examinations

With the GCSE examination period rapidly approaching, I am writing to share some important information around exam arrangements with you.

As with previous years, there will be no formal study leave period for our Year 11 students. This is because we know that the best place for students to continue to learn and revise is in lessons, in front of their subject-specialist teachers.

The GCSE exam period begins on Thursday 9th May, with Religious Studies and Urdu Listening/Reading being the first exams to take place. Students will be expected to attend all timetabled lessons in school up until the end of the GCSE period. The last official exam is Hospitality and Catering exam taking place on the 20th of June.

Students will be sent home after the afternoon exams, if the exam finishes after 3pm. If the exam finishes earlier they will stay at school until the end of the school day. We may choose to send students home after certain exams, but you will be informed of this by text message.

Wednesday 26th of June is the official Contingency day for exams (in the event of national or significant local disruption), so students must be available until this date.

Please be aware that often at this time of year, there can be fake exam papers which are promoted to students on social media. Students need to be aware that the papers being advertised are almost always fake and that there are serious penalties for engaging with these accounts.

We continue to hold high expectations of our students throughout the exam period, and expect students to attend all lessons and exams on time and in full school uniform. Students must ensure they have a clear pencil case with all equipment needed for each exam.
