## Information regarding GCSE examinations & Year 11 Prom

The first few days of the GCSE examination period have gone well. Students have approached the exams with maturity and enthusiasm, despite the last few years of disruptions due to Covid 19.

As with previous years, there will be no formal study leave period for our Year 11 students. This is because we know that the best place for students to continue to learn and revise is in lessons, in front of their subject-specialist teachers. Students are expected to attend all timetabled lessons in school up until the end of the GCSE period – making their official last day on 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

We may choose to send students home after certain exams, but you will be informed of this by text message.

We continue to hold high expectations of our students throughout the exam period, and expect students to attend all lessons and exams on time and in full school uniform. Students must ensure they have a clear pencil case with all equipment needed for each exam.
